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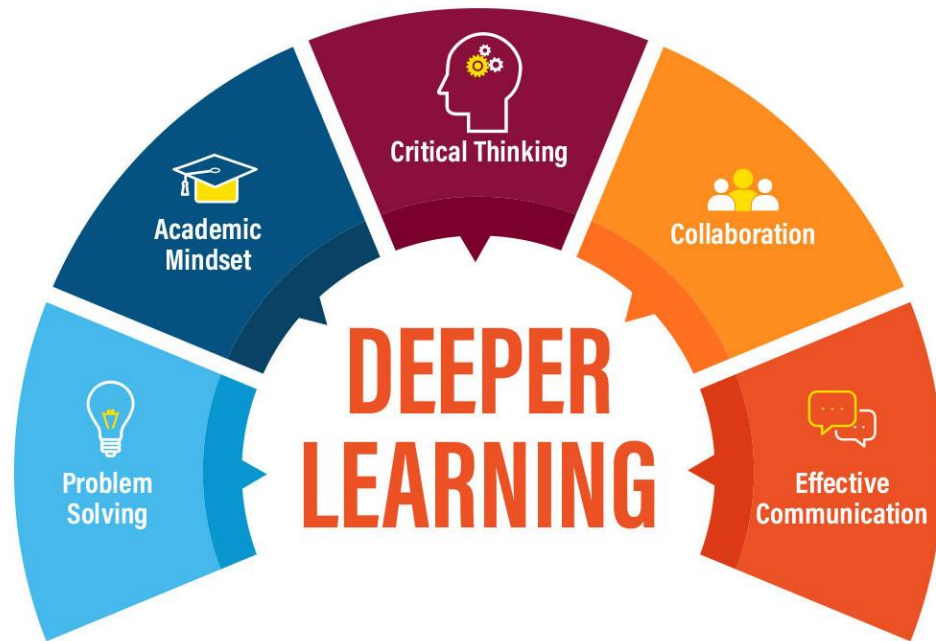

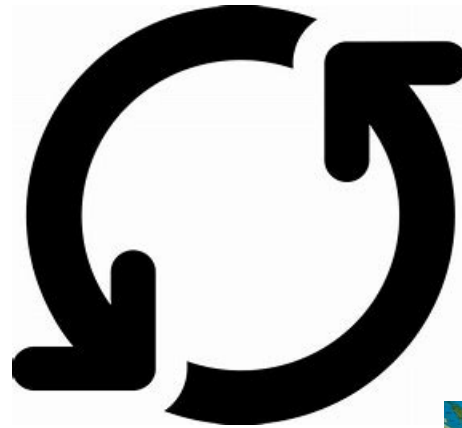

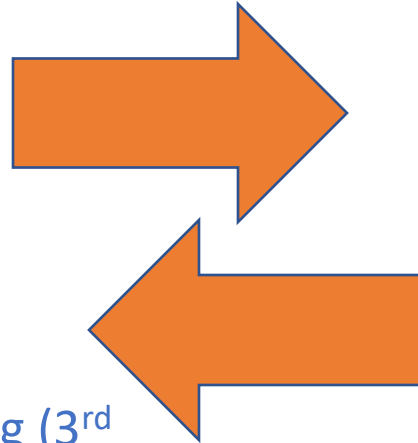

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Home Groups

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Home groups consist of mixed grade levels. First and second graders are mixed with an equal amount from each grade into two different groups. Third and fourth graders are organized the same way.

These groups meet during the afternoon, after lunch, extra-curricular lessons consisting of the following:

Grades 1 and 2- art, sports, music, Bewegungszeit

Grades 3 and 4- music, ethics, Klassenrat, Bewegung

The first and second graders also meet in these groups during their Morgenkreis class on Monday and Friday mornings.
