## **Education Program Overview:**

- Visits to various institutions: the U.N., National Health Institute, Columbia University, Georgetown University
- Seminars & discussions on diplomacy, U.S. cultural, social & educational systems
- English immersion at a local high school, shadow students to classes & after-school programs for two days
- · Homestay with local high school students' families for three nights
- All English-speaking environment & daily journal entries in English, guided by the trip leaders

#### **Requirements:**

- Age 15-18
- Group size 16-20 students
- Individual travel insurance
- Valid passport (a biometric passport featuring a microchip)
- Approved ESTA with online approval OR valid Visa to enter the United States
- Required forms by DAI Heidelberg, such as registration form, liability forms & wavers
